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LANNA's are intended to recognise LANNA students that demonstrate exceptional academic performance, and dedication to the school and its ethos. These scholarships provide assistance with tuition fees, of between 40% and 80%, and are available only to current LANNA students transitioning from Y11 into Y12. Scholarships that are awarded continue through into Y13, subject to review during semester 2 of Year 12.

To apply, students must meet the following criteria:

Currently predicted to obtain top grades in a wide range of IGCSE subjects. Student displays strong character and commitment to community and school life

e.g. involvement and leadership in extra-curricular activities (sports, arts, LIPSO, Student Council, MUN, LQ, etc.); mentoring new students; peer tutoring; community service

Parents are committed to the school and their child's ongoing education at LANNA e.g. involvement and/or leadership in the PTO; assisting with extra-curricular activities

The student has special talents or qualities that will add value to life at LANNA
